- ALWAYS anchor the PRIMED Backstop as instructed prior to use. An unsecured backstop can cause serious
 injury.
- The PRIMED Backstop should be placed on a flat surface that is suitable for play while ensuring maximum user safety.
- Do not leave the PRIMED Backstop outdoors in inclement weather as moisture and other elements may adversely affect the performance of the unit.
- Ensure all components are properly assembled prior to use.
- Examine your PRIMED Backstop regularly for wear and tear. Discontinue use immediately if any defect is found.
- Keep away from fire and heat sources.

- Failure to follow the above mentioned Warnings may result in injury.




BEFORE ASSEMBLY:


DIAGRAMS FOR PARTS





ASSEMBLING THE BACKSTOP NET







Assemble frame as shown in **Figure 1**. Please note that all tubes are numbered according to **Figure 1** and parts list. Make sure you pick the correct number tube for assembling. During assembly, be sure that all snap buttons are secure as seen in **Figure 3**. To start, please leave all hardware in a hand tightened position until the frame is complete. Once the Backstop is fully constructed go back and secure all hardware.

Follow the steps below to assemble the bottom frame. Please reference Figure 1 for further clarification.

- 1. Connect two Part #7's to Part #3.
- 2. Connect Part #8 to Part #3.
- 3. Connect Part #6 to Part #3 and #8 using two Butterfly Nut and Bolt sets, Part #13, per Figure 4.
- 4. Connect Part #2 to Part #8.
- 5. Connect Part #5 to Part #2.
- 6. Connect Part #14 to Part #5.
- 7. Connect two Part #7's to Part #14
- 8. Connect Part #8 to Part #14.
- 9. Connect Part #6 to Part #14 and #8 using two Butterfly Nut and Bolt sets, Part #13, per Figure 4...
- 10. Connect Part #2 to Part #8.
- 11. Connect Part #8 to Part #2.
- 12. Connect Part #9 to Part #8.
- 13. Connect two Part #7's to Part #9.
- 14. Connect Part #6 to Part #9 and #8 using two Butterfly Nut and Bolt sets, Part #13, per Figure 4..
- 15. Connect Part #15 to Part #9.
- 16. Connect Part #2 to Part #15.
- 17. Connect Part #8 to Part #2.
- 18. Connect Part #4 to Part #8.
- 19. Connect two Part #7's to Part #4.
- 20. Connect Part #6 to Part #4 and #8 using two Butterfly Nut and Bolt sets, Part #13, per Figure 4..
- 21. Layout the net, Part #12, per Figure 8.
- 22. Connect Part #1 to Part #2. Secure the left end of the net/net ties to Part #1 and #2 poles per **Figure 2.** Make sure that the top of the net is hooked on to the hook on Part #1, per **Figure 6**.
- 23. Repeat step 22 for right upright poles.
- 24. Repeat step 22 for the two mid upright Poles.
- 25. Connect left most upright poles, Part #1 and #2 with the net tied, to the left Part #3.
- 26. Repeat step 25 for other three upright poles and connect to Part #3, #9, and #14 accordingly per Figure 1.
- 27. Tie the bottom of the Net, Part #12, zip ties to each of the bottom poles, Part #3, #4, 9, and #14.
- 28. Place one Ground J-hook one each of Part #7 per Figure 7 and 9.
- 29. Check the assembly against illustrations and tighten all nuts and bolts securely.

Note: Please note that the net can be adjusted three different angles.

- a. 0 degrees per figure 9.
- b. 45 degrees per figure 10.
- c. 90 degrees per figure 11.
